

BLACK HISTORY MONTH

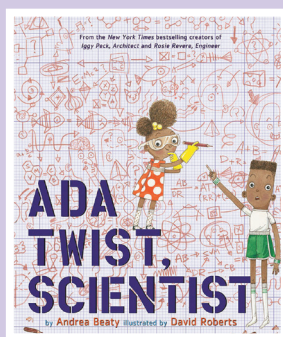

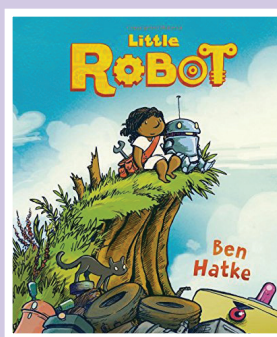

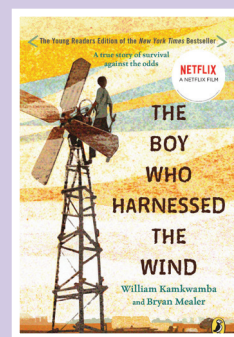

BLACK HERITAGE TRAIL (self-guided tours can be conducted at any time) Similar to the Freedom Trail, the The Black Heritage Trail explores the history of the 19th century African American community of Boston. Includes the Abiel Smith School and the African Meeting House.

BOSTON CHILDREN'S MUSEUM—STORY QUILTS An important part of Black and African American culture in North America for many years, telling stories and sharing history. Share your family's story and add it to a collaborative Story Quilt.

MARY BAKER EDDY LIBRARY A fun-filled week of educational programming, exploring true and inspiring stories of achievement. Workshops require registration, art activities, film screenings, and Mapparium tours do not.

JFK LIBRARY—ROSA'S RIDE With original songs, inspirational scenes, and exciting dances traces how Rosa Parks handled various experiences of discrimination which sparked the modern civil rights movement.

DAVIS MUSEUM, WELLESLEY, MA Join a Student Guide for a drop-in tour celebrating Black History Month. Tours will focus on the arts of Africa and the African Diaspora in the Davis Museum permanent collections.

FEB 28, 6 -8 PM

BOSTON CHILDREN'S CHOIR The Boston Children's Chorus perform at Hibernian Hall. The concert tells the stories of the Civil Rights Movement's hidden women.
