## Attendance and Chronic Absenteeism

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- Post-COVID, there has been a significant statewide decrease in student daily attendance, and a significant increase in chronic absenteeism
- Chronic absenteeism is defined as missing $10 \%$ or more of school, or 18 days over the course of a school year
- Identified as a priority issue by DESE and the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education
- Our data in Westwood show similar trends for student daily attendance and chronic absenteeism

| $\%$ of students chronically absent (non-high school) | $2.6 \%$ | $2.4 \%$ | $7.3 \%$ | $7.0 \%$ |
| $\%$ of students chronically absent (high school) | $6.1 \%$ | $7.1 \%$ | $14.9 \%$ | $13.6 \%$ |
