EXPECTATIONS FOR VIDEO CONFERENCING:

- □ Join from a quiet, distraction-free location.
- Avoid multitasking; Close any tabs you do not need for the session.
- Mute your microphone unless you are speaking to cut down on background noise let the teacher (host) mute and unmute.
- With permission from your teacher, use the chat feature to ask or answer questions.. Be purposeful and stay on-topic.
- □ Conferencing is for connecting with your teacher/s and academic discussions, not socializing.
- □ Try not to speak over one another; To get your teacher's attention, you can raise your hand on screen or say "I have a question" in the chat, or turn off your audio whichever way your teacher advises
- □ Use signals you normally use at school, such as a silent cheer or 'Me too' to signify agreement or applause.
- □ Only participate in video conferences initiated and led by a teacher.
