

# WESTWOOD HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to earn a minimum of 115 credits to graduate from Westwood High School. Of those 115 credits, 83.25 must be earned within specific subject areas:

## SUBJECT AREA REQUIREMENTS

(courses can be in level 1, 2, or 3)

English	20 Credits/4 years
Mathematics	15 Credits/3 years
Science	17 Credits/3 years
Social Studies	10 Credits/2 years (including U.S. History)
Foreign Language	10 Credits/2 years
Art	5 Credits/1 year
Wellness	5 Credits/2 semesters
Public Speaking	1.25 Credits/1 semester

The graduation requirements are minimal credit requirements. For students who desire a rigorous comprehensive high school experience in preparation for college, the school offers options that substantially exceed the basic requirements.
