Dear 6th Grade Families:

We are very fortunate in Westwood to have Hale Reservation—a wonderful educational and recreational resource—right in our own backyard. For more than a decade, Thurston has joined forces with Hale to offer a variety of education programs and field trips for our students. In the past four years, Thurston students engaged in a variety of academic and team-building activities thanks to an expanded partnership with Hale.

Each Spring our Team Leaders work closely with the Hale staff to design fun, interactive, and educational experiences for our students. This year we organized the program so that all 6th graders are provided with the opportunity to take-on various elements in the ropes course. We also tried to closely match the problem solving aspects of the experience with themes that should resonate to our incoming 6th graders. All students will have the chance to experience academic and team-building activities as well as enjoy learning beyond the walls of the schoolhouse. See the below for more details:

Our goal is to make this trip possible for every child and therefore, full or partial financial aid is available. Please contact your child's guidance counselor to request financial assistance for this or other school-related costs. The cost is **\$50 per child**.

Money contributed by parents helps pay for two items: the services provided by Hale and the cost of busing. What drives the cost of Hale's programs? For starters, students spend the day in small groups, and each group has a facilitator. The cost of insurance is included in Hale's program as well. Hale staff have specialized skills and training that allow them to run activities like the ropes course. Most importantly, Hale offers kids a valuable opportunity to engage in learning activities in a totally different environment--something that we strongly believe contributes to their overall growth and development as students and as people.
