GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS (Policy IKFA)

"The College Preparatory Program of Studies is a pattern of courses designed to prepare students for admission to a four-year college or university. Almost all students spend four years completing this program. A student following this program may opt for more difficult classes in his or her areas of strength. Please see the Program of Studies Booklet for specific course suggestions.

To receive a Westwood High School diploma, a student must earn a minimum of 115 credits (meeting minimum credit requirements in subject areas listed below) and pass the MCAS examination in Math, English Language Arts, and Science and Technology.

Of these credits, the following subject area requirements must be met:

20.00 Credits of English

15.00 Credits of Mathematics

17.00 Credits of Science

10.00 Credits of Social Studies (including United States History)

7.00 Credits of Wellness

5.00 Credits of Fine Art (Art, Music, or Performing Arts courses)

10.0 Credits of World Language (must complete a 2 year sequence in one language)

2.5 Civics and Public Speaking

1.25 Civics

1.25 Public Speaking (for students in the Class of 2025 and earlier)

1.25 Financial Literacy (for students in the Class of 2026 and beyond)

Credits necessary to advance to the next grade level:

To advance to the 11th grade: 52.5 credits
To advance to the 12th grade: 85 credits
Graduation Requirement 115
