





MSBA Overview Timeline

What's Next with MSBA: Enrollment Number Agreement

In August, we responded to questions from the MSBA regarding:

- Educational Questions
 - Our educational programs and philosophy
 - Current grade-level and building configuration
 - Special Education models and program structure
 - •Very preliminary thinking about possible changes to the above as a result of a building project (e.g., moving preschool into an elementary building)

What's Next with MSBA: Enrollment Number Agreement

In August, we responded to questions from the MSBA regarding:

- Enrollment Data and Demographic Information, such as
 - Historic enrollment data
 - Enrollment projections
 - Building permits
 - Birth rates
 - Real estate development

What's Next with MSBA: Enrollment Number Agreement

- •MSBA experts will use this information and their established methodology to create an enrollment projection for the project.
- The district has similar information from its Master Plan study in 2015.
- The district is currently working with NESDEC to provide us with an update to this information based on any new variables since 2015.
- •We will engage in a process with MSBA to agree upon an enrollment projection by November 28 that will serve as a premise for the Feasibility Study.

Forming Project Team and Feasibility Study (March 2019 - Spring 2020)

First Tasks:

- •Hire Owner's Project Manager (OPM) SBC Task
- Select the Designer MSBA-led process in collaboration with the district

These two tasks will take about 4-6 months to complete.

Other Decisions/Tasks for This Year

- Begin the Feasibility Study sooner?
- Consider timeline for community input. (This spring?)
