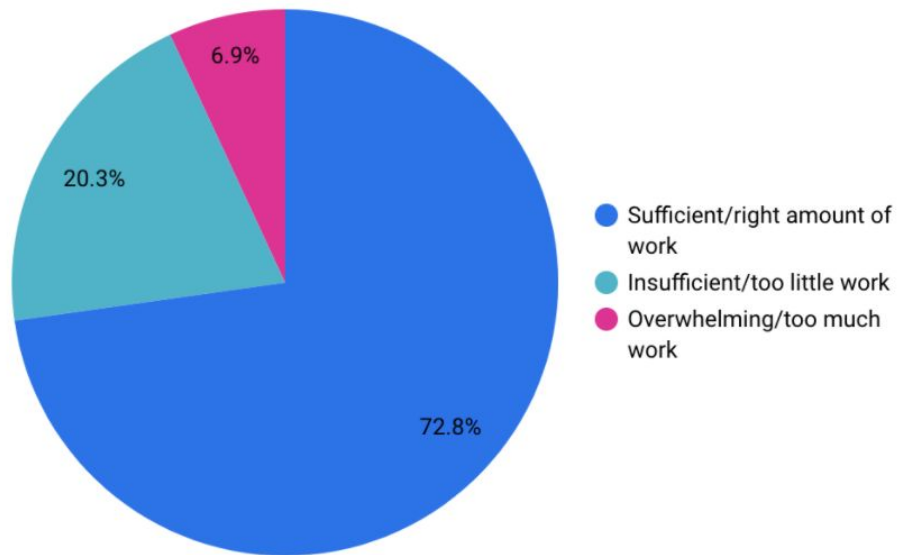

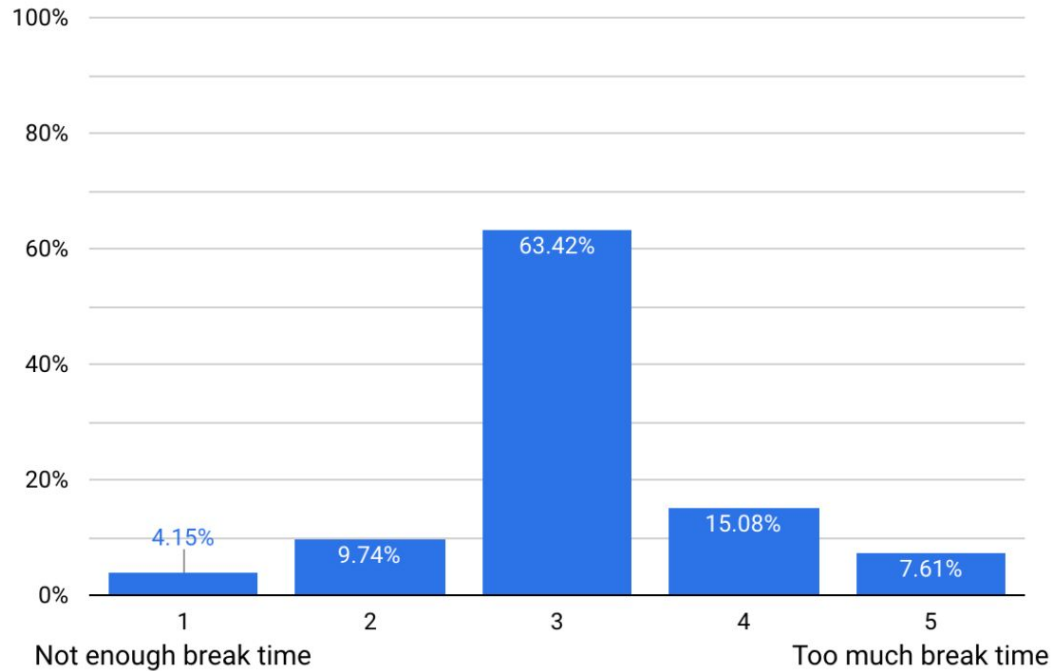




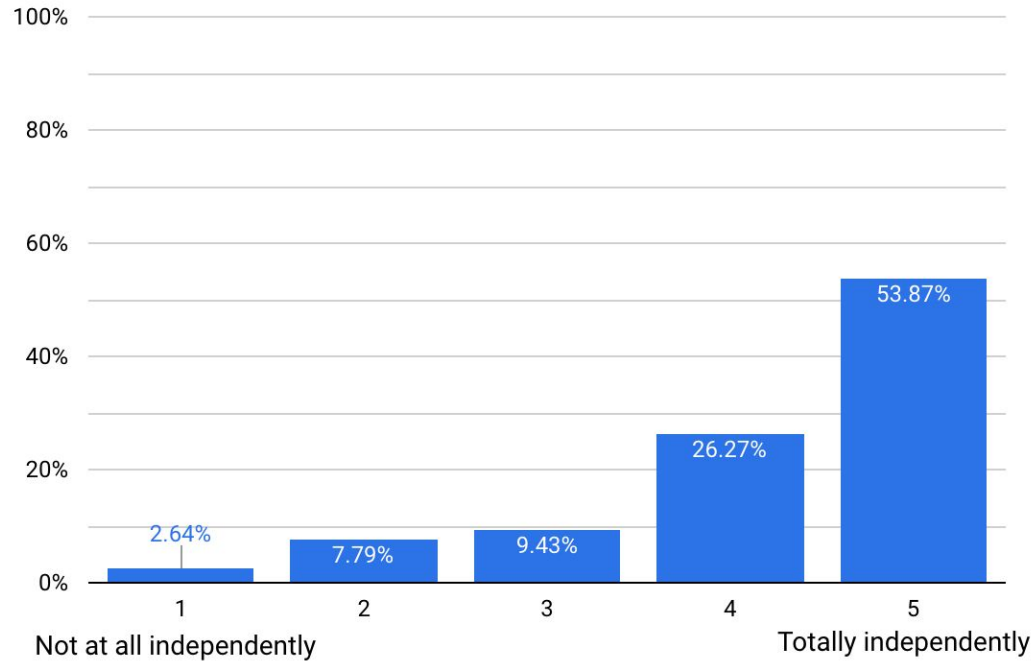
Between full class video conference sessions, group work, help sessions and independent work time, how would you categorize your child's workload on remote days?



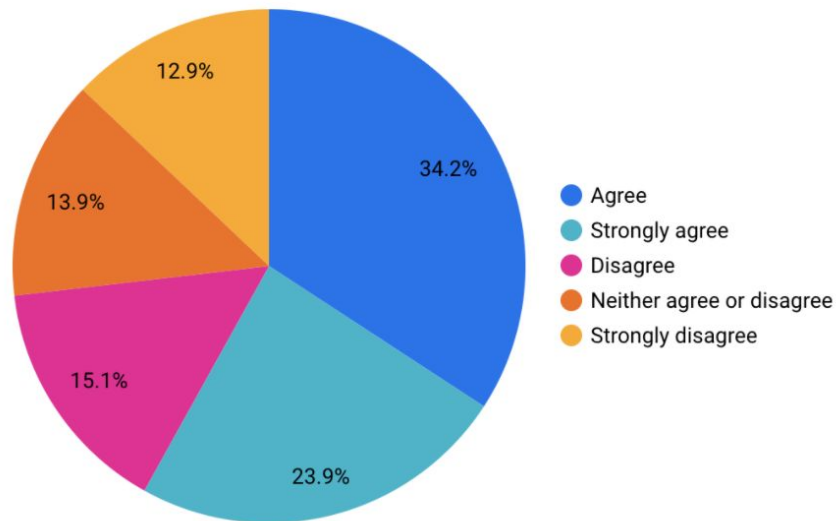
Does your child have adequate break time for things like movement/stretch breaks, lunch, or play time on remote days?



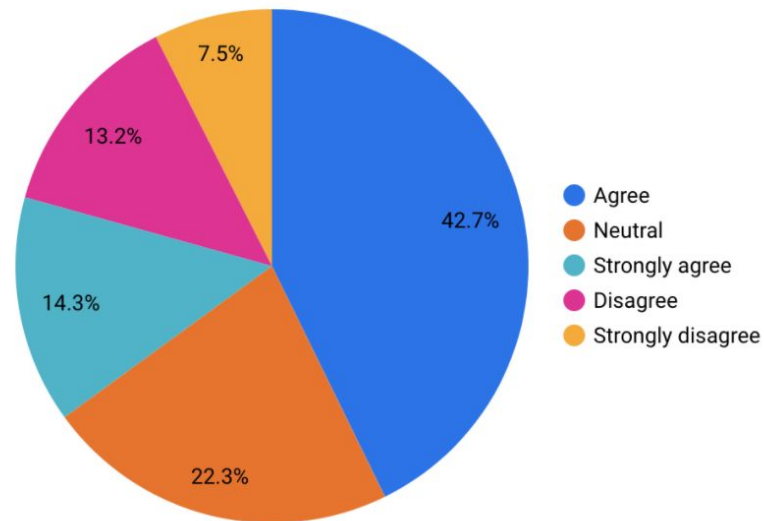
How independently is your child able to navigate technology in order to participate in remote instruction and complete assignments?

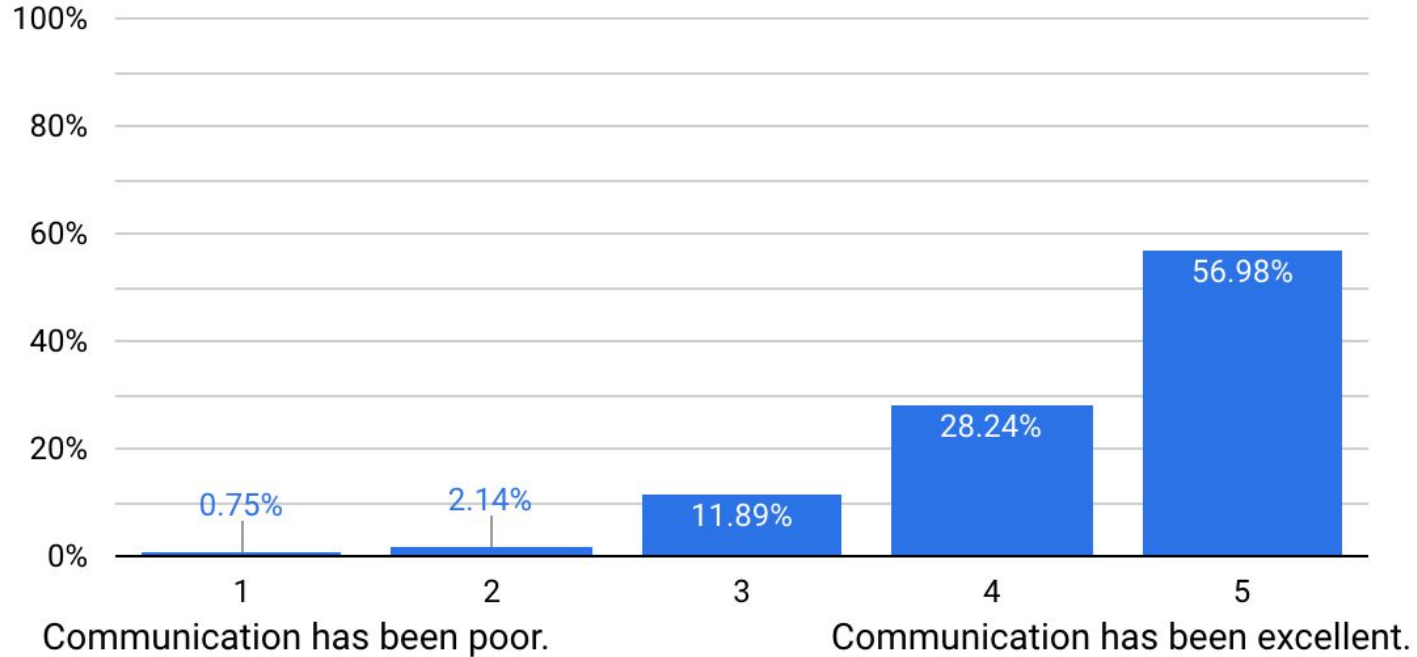

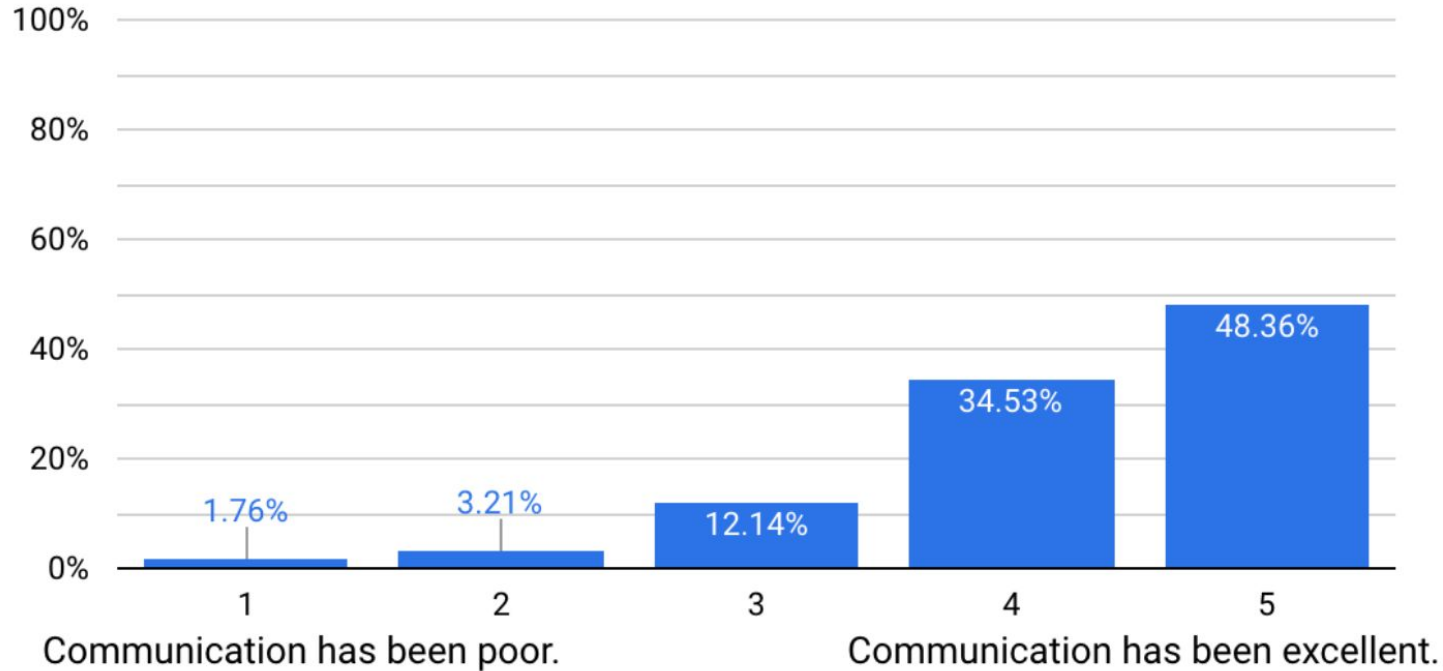

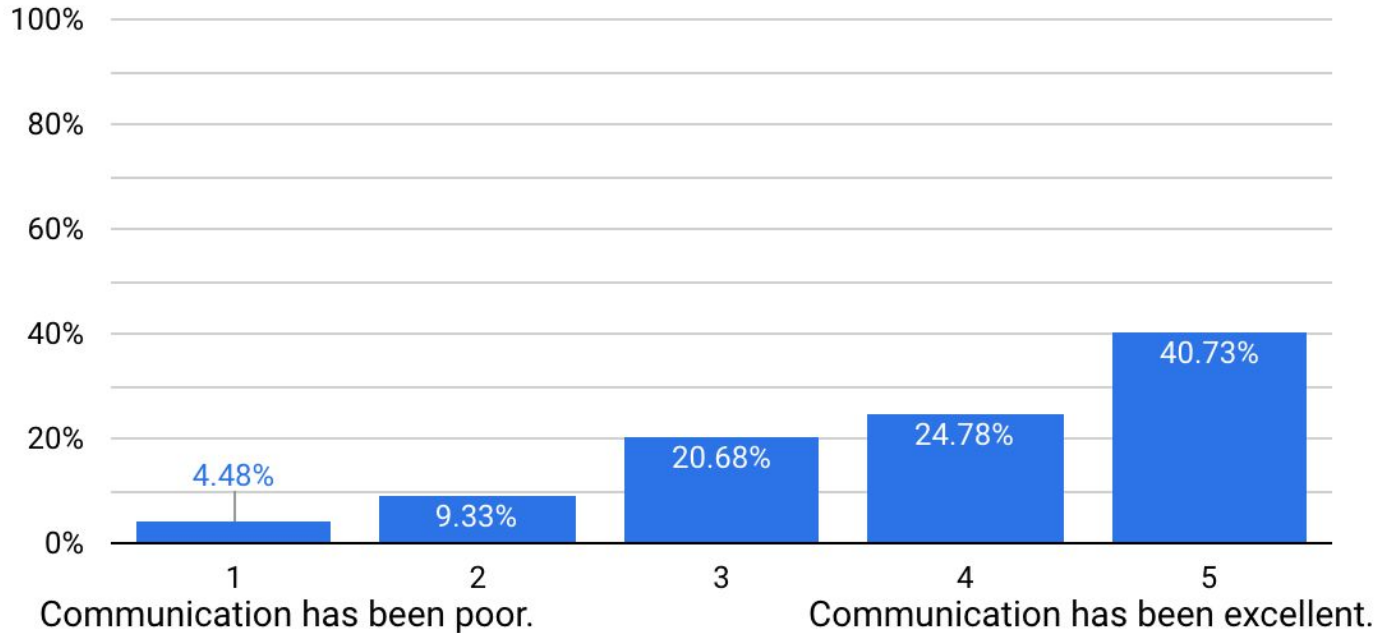
Overall, how would you rate communication from THE DISTRICT in terms of timing, quantity and quality?



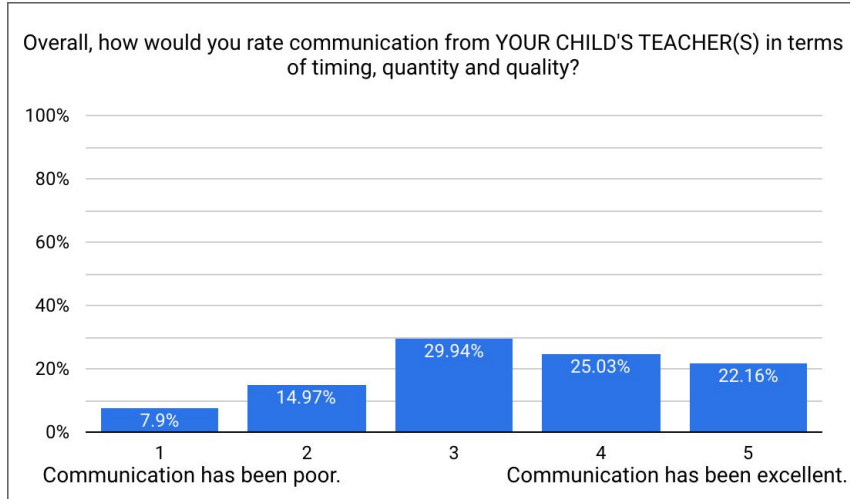
Overall, how would you rate communication from YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL in terms of timing, quantity and quality?



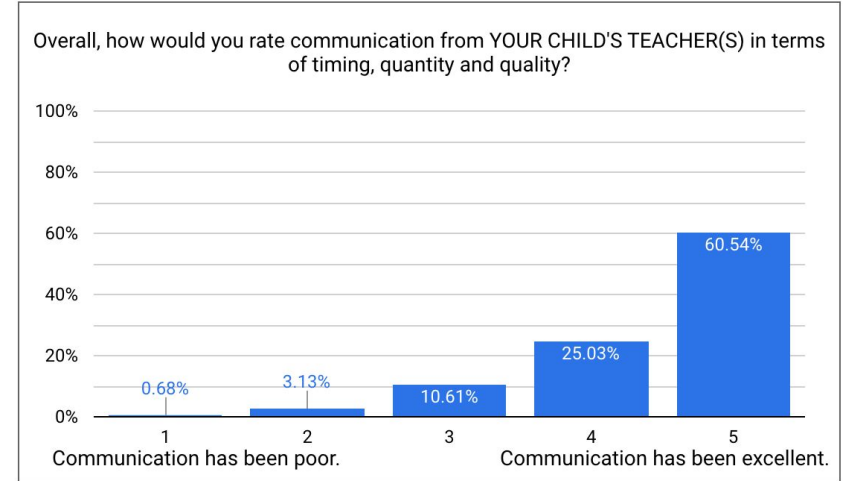
Overall, how would you rate communication from YOUR CHILD'S TEACHER(S) in terms of timing, quantity and quality?

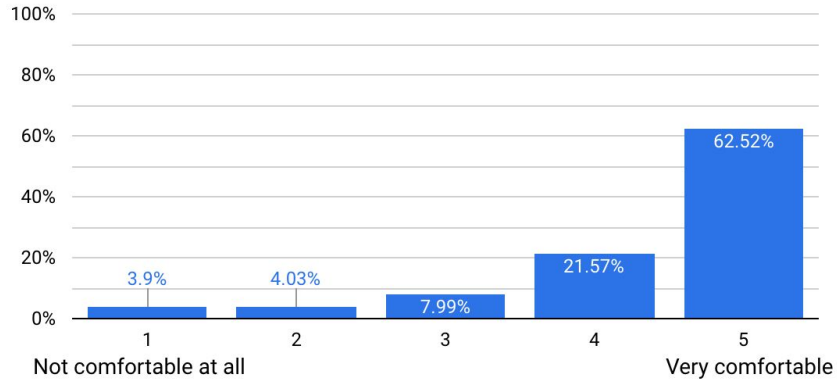

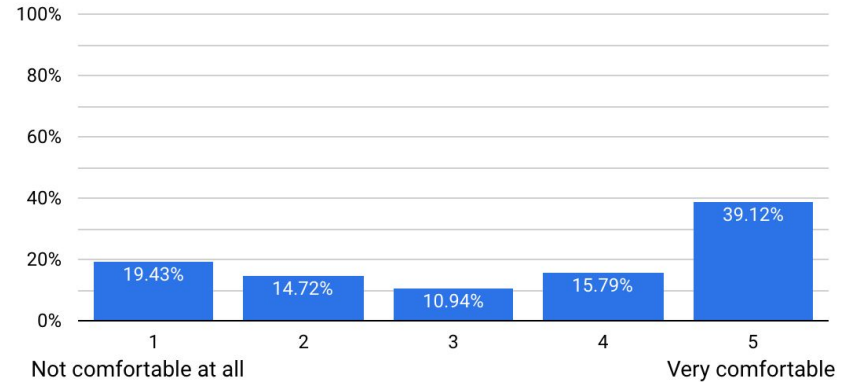

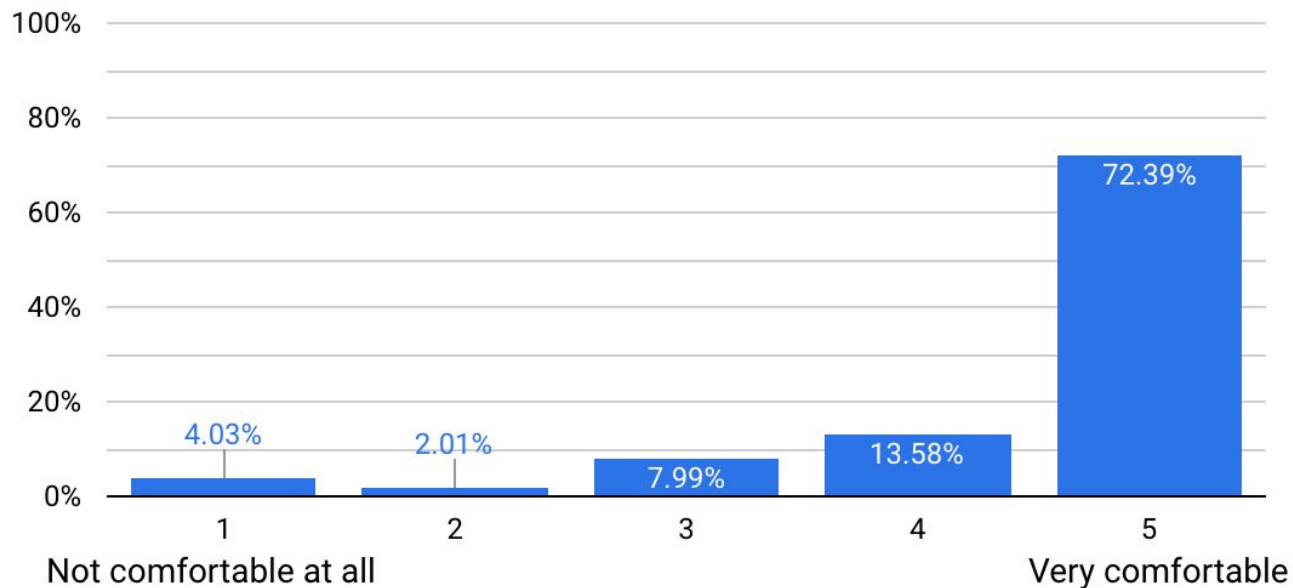

The district is exploring offering free rapid COVID-19 testing for students who are symptomatic. If your child qualified for testing, how likely would you be to make use of this service?

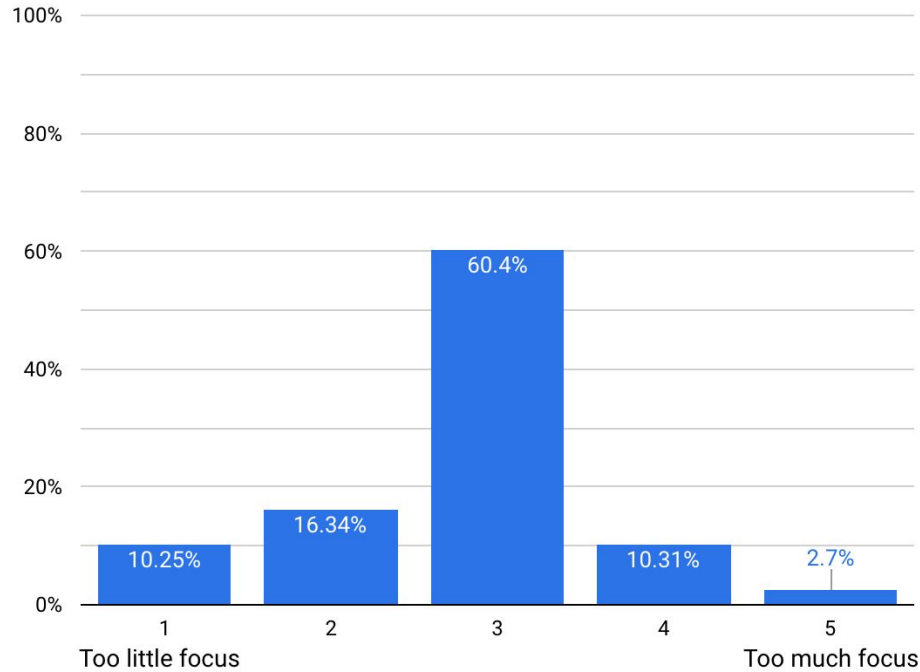


If Westwood were able to implement a periodic surveillance testing program, would you consent to having your child participate?

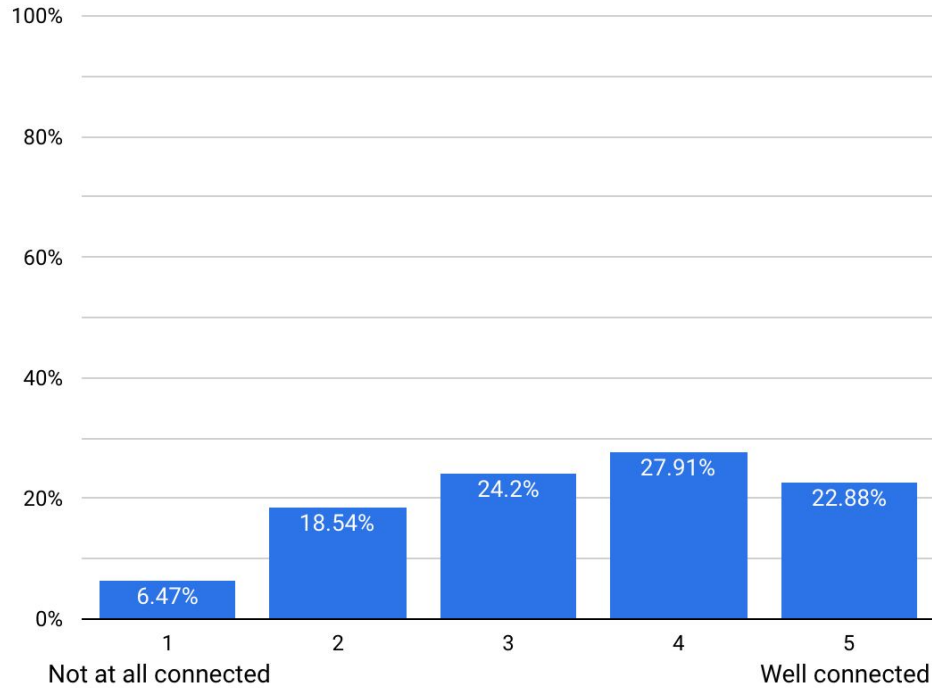
