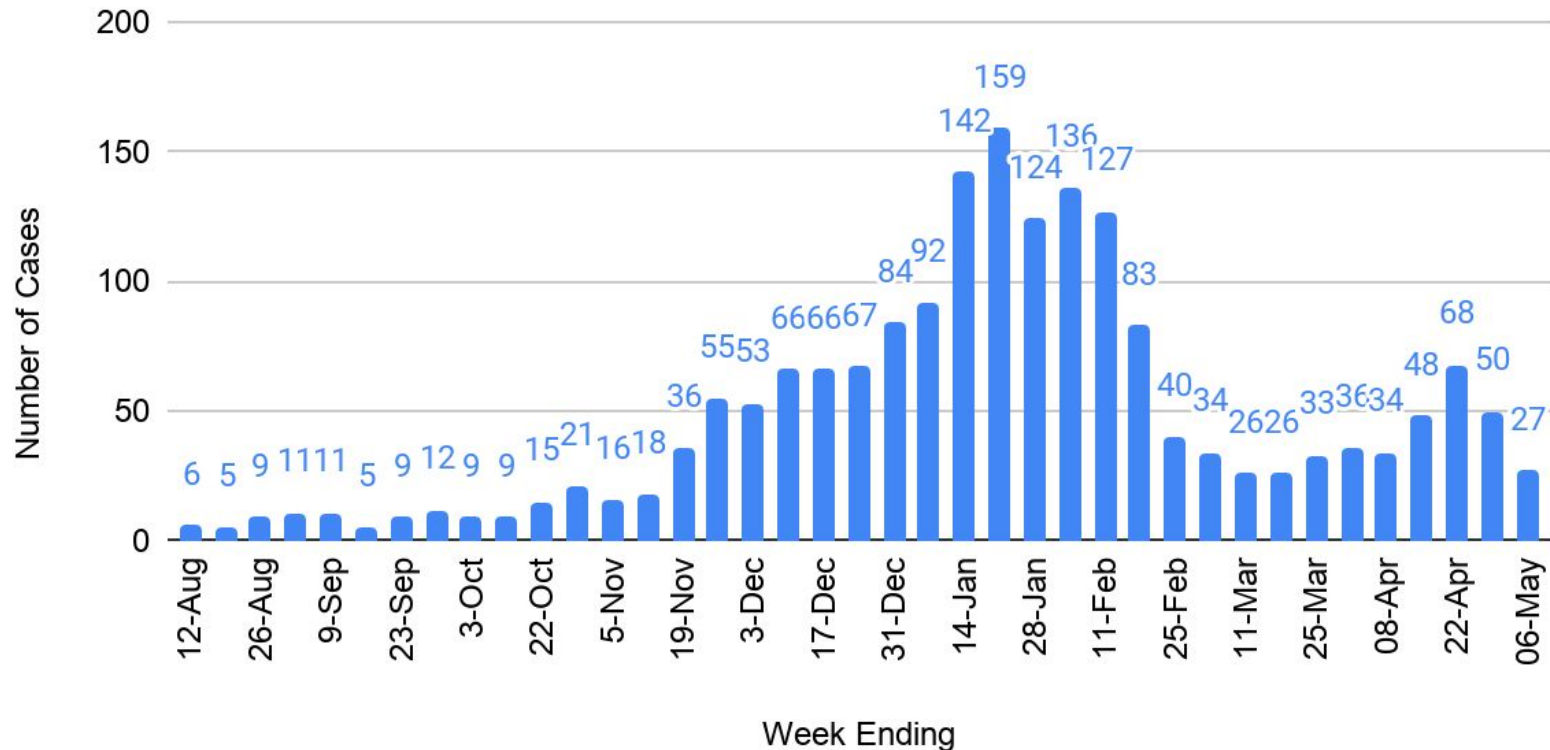


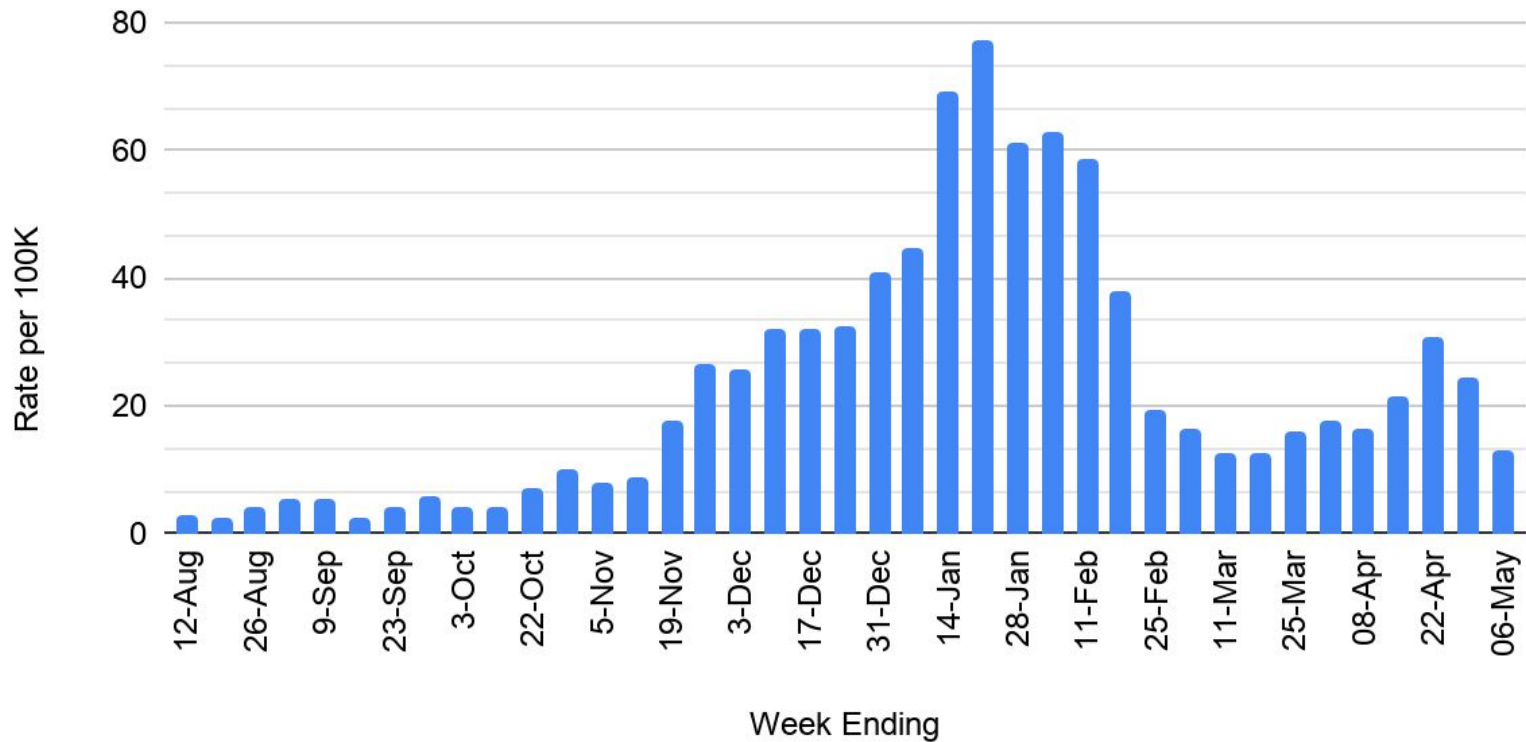
# WW COVID Case Count

Last 14 days



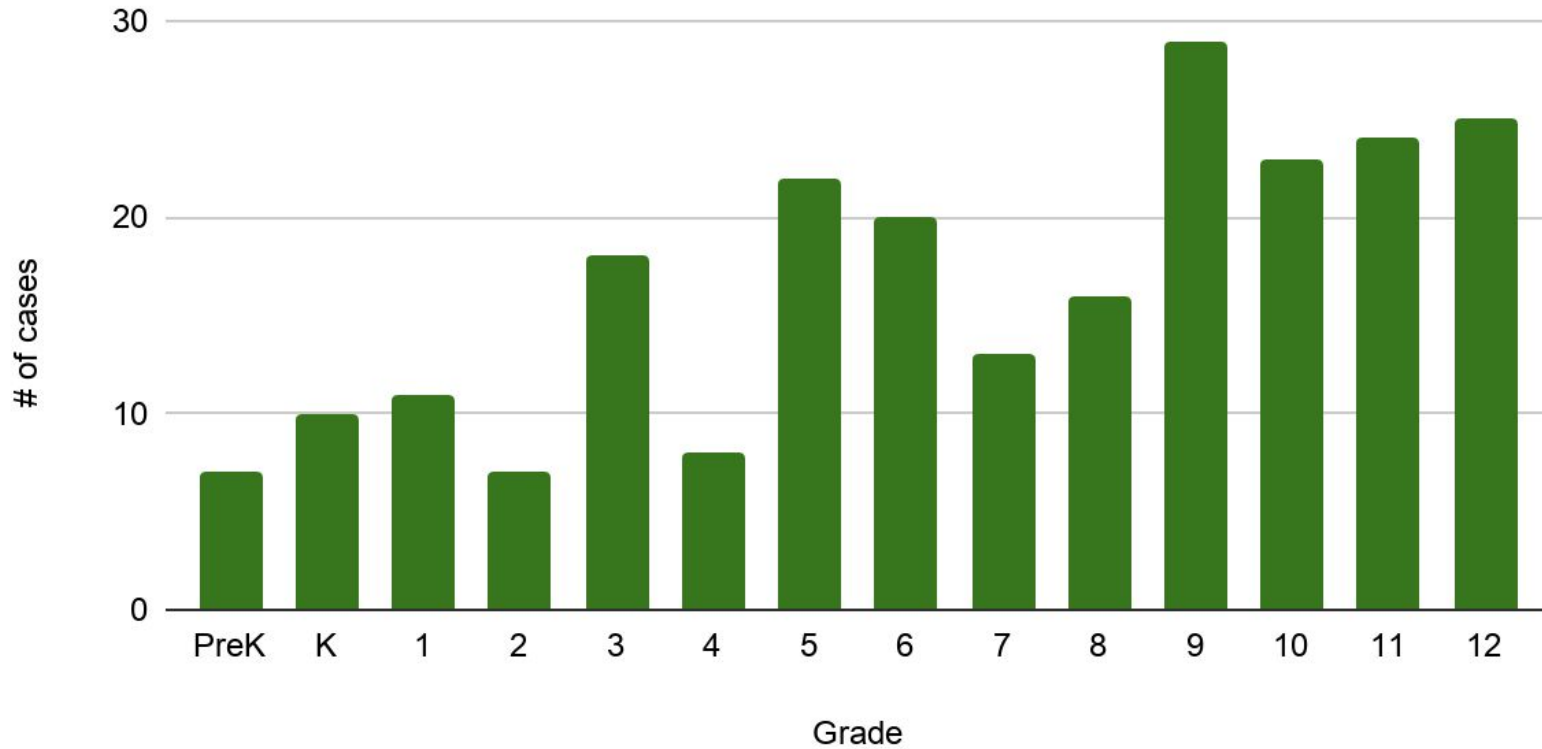
# The WPS COVID Team:

So far this school year:

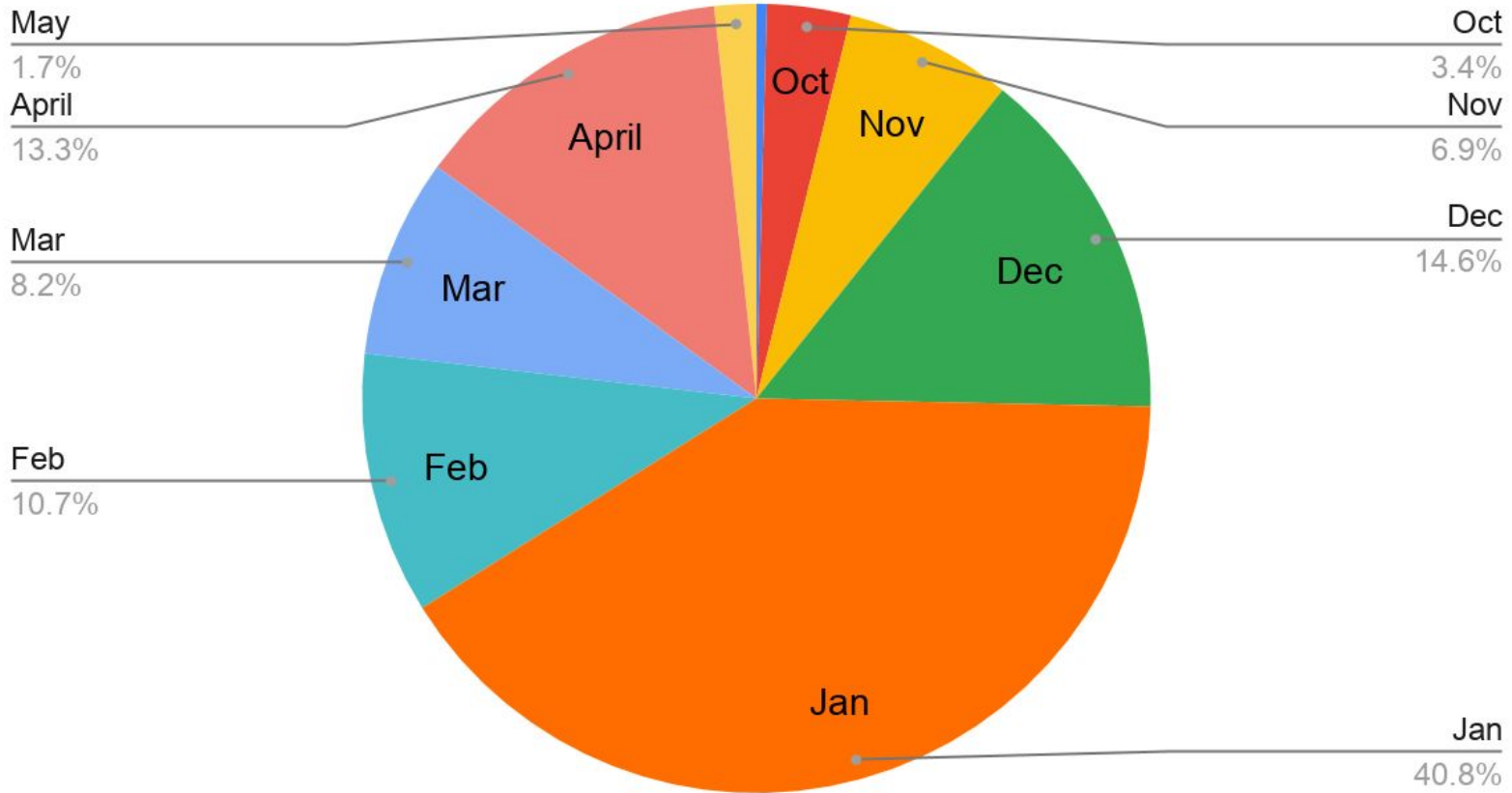
- 272 positive cases (students and staff)

# Updated Guidance re: Quarantines

- Definition of “close contact” remains the same (i.e. within 6 ft for 15 minutes of more cumulatively, even when masked).
- Only close contacts within 3 ft need to quarantine.
- Other close contacts (3-6 ft) do not need to quarantine as long as they remain symptom-free.

# Pool Testing Update:

- The state has announced that it will continue to fund pool testing through the end of August.
- WPS will continue the pool testing for students and staff in summer programs.
- Staff testing participation continues to decline as staff members are fully vaccinated.
