 - Volunteered or contributed meaningfully to the school or local community.
 - Demonstrated compassion, loyalty, and a willingness to support peers or family.
- 3. How the funds will be distributed, and over what time frame. For example, a one-time scholarship for a certain amount of money, an annual scholarship for a certain amount of money, a lump sum deposit to be paid out over a number of years, etc.
 - We will start the fund with \$10,000 and add over time. We were thinking of awarding \$2,000 per year to one or two students. We will take the committee's recommendation on what they feel is best.
