Initiative Scope & Parameters



Structures must be able to be removed, stored, and reinstalled if necessary, based on future decisions by the Town regarding the Sheehan property.




The playground will not be resurfaced; woodchips will remain.



Initiative Outcomes

The Sheehan Playground Committee is donating **\$35,000** towards the purchase and installation of a new climbing structure at the Sheehan playground site and seeks School Committee approval for the gift.



Structure Recommendation

- Recommendation to purchase the Burke Nucleus Core Climber was made with input from Sheehan School principal Kristen Evans, school staff, and reputable local playground design company.
- The Sheehan playground does not currently have any similar equipment. We know, from watching our children, that such climbers are popular on other town playgrounds (e.g., School Street, Pine Hill).
- The Nucleus Core Climber is relatively vertical, making installation simpler: other structures do not need to be removed.

Installation

- Lead time: 8 weeks
 - If PO issued 9/12, install ~11/20
- Duration: 4 days
 - Entire playground closed
- Timing: Install as late as Dec, pending ground condition
 - Structure may be purchased now to secure price, then prioritized for 2026 install if necessary
