Deerfield Bus Code of Conduct

Expected Bus Behaviors:

- 1. Stay in your seat until the bus stops.
- 2. Keep hands and feet to yourself.
- 3. Tell the bus driver about dangerous and destructive ("Double D") behavior.
- 4. Keep hands and objects inside the windows.
- 5. Limit 3 people to a seat.
- 6. Use an "indoor voice" and kind words.
- 7. Be kind to everyone.

Never Allowed Bus Behaviors:

- 1. Eating and drinking, including gum or candy
- Standing up or changing seats while the bus is moving
- 3. Punching, kicking, pushing, pinching, or other negative physical behavior
- 4. Seeing or hearing dangerous or destructive behavior and not reporting it to an adult (e.g. bus driver, parent, teacher, Mr. Baumer)
- 5. Putting hands, head, or items out the windows
- 6. More than 3 people in a seat
- 7. Yelling, swearing, insulting, teasing, mimicking, or other mean talking or negative language
- 8. Being mean, not including others, using negative gestures or body language, even if it's meant to be a joke

Consequences if it has been determined Never Allowed Behaviors have occurred:

- Grant First Time:
 - □ I will meet with Mr. Baumer to review the Expected Bus Behaviors.
 - □ Mr. Baumer will contact my parents.
- □ Second Time:
 - □ I will have an assigned seat at the front of the bus for a week or more.
 - □ Mr. Baumer will contact my parents.
- □ Third Time:
 - □ I will have a permanent assigned seat at the front of the bus.
 - □ Mr. Baumer will meet with my parents and me.
- □ Fourth Time:
 - □ I will lose my bus privileges for the remainder of the school year.
 - □ My parents will be responsible for driving me to and from school.
 - □ Mr. Baumer will meet with my parents and me.
