The subject areas include land use, town centers, housing, economic development, natural and cultural resources, community facilities, open and recreation space, transportation, resilience and sustainability, and implementation. The Town is seeking candidates to serve on the Steering Committee who have an interest and expertise in one or more of these subject areas. Selected Steering Committee members will be responsible for collecting information and writing portions of the plan. We need your help with this update!
