Incoming Grades 3-8

The fee for the 10-week Fall 2019 season, which starts September 7, 2019, is \$125 per player. Some travel is involved for all teams. Practices are held during the week with games scheduled on Saturdays. **All registered children make a team.**

Incoming Grades K-2

The Mites K-2 program is a **FULL year, Fall 2019-Spring 2020, program** and does **NOT** require re-registration in the spring. The fee for the full-year in-town program is \$125. Children must be registered for Kindergarten for the fall 2019 to play K soccer.

Late Fee

Registrations completed after the 12:00 midnight June 21, 2019 deadline will be considered late and systematically assessed a \$25 per player late fee. Late fees cannot be waived. Fee waivers will NOT be granted for late registrations. Late registrants will be placed on a space available basis. Late fees are not assessed in the Kindergarten program.

Financial Hardship Fee Waivers

Requests for registration fee waivers due to financial hardship must come during **OPEN registration from May 22 – June 21**. Fee waivers for late registrations will not be granted.

Please consider volunteering! Soccer knowledge a plus, but not a requirement. If you want to submit your name to be considered for a Coach, Assistant Coach, or Parent Manager position please select the appropriate volunteer option and complete the volunteer information when you are registering your child during this online registration process.

Kindergarten Screening
Newspaper Announcement**

Under the requirements of Massachusetts Special Education Law, the Westwood Public Schools is required to screen all children that reside in Westwood and are entering kindergarten to identify students who may have a disability that would interfere with their ability to make effective progress in an educational environment. Kindergarten screening includes an assessment of the child's development in the areas of cognition, language, and motor skills.

Kindergarten Screenings will be held as follows:

Deerfield School	June 5, 2019
Downey School	May 23, 28 & 29, 2019
Hanlon School	May 30, 2019
Martha Jones School	June 3 & 4, 2019
Sheehan School	June 4, 5 & 6, 2019

If your child does not attend Kindergarten in the Westwood Public Schools and will turn five years old by September 1, 2019, please contact the Westwood Public School's Student Services Department for a screening appointment. All screenings must be completed by October 31, 2019.
