PROOF OF RESIDENCY AND OCCUPANCY

In order to register and attend the Westwood Public Schools, a student must reside in the Town of Westwood with a parent/legal guardian. The Westwood Public Schools requires proof of residency/occupancy when students are initially enrolled.

The following documents will be required as proof of a physical address in Westwood when new students are registered.

Proof of Residency (Provide one from this list.)	Proof of Occupancy (Provide two from this list within 45 days of registration.)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Most recent mortgage payment• Most recent property tax bill• Copy of current signed lease*	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cable/Satellite TV/Internet bill or work order• Electric bill or "statement of service" letter• Gas bill or "statement of service" letter• Home telephone (wireless is not accepted) bill or work order• Home/renter's insurance bill, policy, or "statement of service" letter

*Please note that the District will contact lease-holders annually to update our files with a current lease for the new school year.
