2. Budget (Paula Timofeev)		
7:38pm-7:45pm	Discussion: Review 2018-2019 budget items	

- As of 11/6/18, 132 families have paid dues, the number has gone up since last meeting, and some dues are slowly trickling in.
- Halloween party netted out at about \$1600, high numbers due in part to no bounce houses, and Monique being an "awesome" shopper
- Current apparel sales at about \$1790 way better than usual.
- Bake sale brought in about \$800 including a \$250 donation from Wegmans.
- Outdoor classroom has cost about \$800 so far.
- Enrichment \$7200 been paid so far, budget is \$11,000. If we need more \$ for enrichment than the allotted \$11,000, board will have to vote to amend budget.
- Field trips quiet so far, only one has happened. Probably more money will be needed for buses in the spring.
- Total bank account balance at about \$50,000, we are well positioned for future expenses.
- Request from Mrs. Gallagher to purchase 20 books of Rescue and Jessica for the teachers can be paid from teacher request budget, Question: how transparent does the treasurer need to be with the board?
- Request for funding for Rescue books was granted by the PTO.

#### 4. School Play (Sarah Young-Hong and Paula Timofeev)

7:50-8:10pm Discussion: Play Update

- We found a director!
- Retired school teacher, a lot of experience with drama with older kids
- Has worked in elementary education.
- Should be a really good fit.
- Waiting for Mrs. Gallagher's input, we have never hired anyone outside of the district for this position before.
- Teacher needs to be Cori checked through Westwood.
- Will Erin McManus still co-direct? Yes, she has still expressed interest.
- Point made by Principal Gallagher that the committee should go over practice schedule and dismissal times with Diane and new
  director to avoid confusion.
- New director wants rehearsals 2x a week on Tuesdays and Thursdays for a quality production.
- She would like to work with 1 cast twice a week, she can be here at dismissal, and kids can get started at 3:15.
- Proposed 3:15-5/5:15 rehearsal time block
- Space needs to be booked out for use for the play; we may not use the music room this year because the room is in use by a classroom teacher.
- Idea for dividers to be used for the space in the cafeteria since all students will be in there for practice.
- Question: should PTO buy the dividers, Answer: we wouldn't have a place to store it at Downey.
- Question: could we use back hallway? Unofficial answer: "yes."
- Play to take place potentially the 1<sup>st</sup> weekend in April (2 performances), rehearsal could start at the end of January with auditions at the beginning of January.
- Question: What is the plan for all kids in the play?
- Director wants to do a preregistration to determine the numbers.
- Point made: We are going to have double the kids at one time if we are not dividing into 2 casts.
- Director wants to have a parent meeting to review expectations for the production.
- Any other options for director? Answer: Not really. No one wanted to commit for a play with 2 casts 4 productions, up to 100 students
- Other option was the 2 week compressed program with Mrs. Starsiak
- We did have one other fabulous first choice but that person wasn't available to align their hours to fit the needs of our community.
- Question: Will there be flexibility with students who have conflicts with after school activities? Answer: this will have to be addressed at the parent informational meeting.
- Concern: Fear that older kids will have a challenge committing to 2x a week due to other after school activities and we will end up with a much younger cast, is the 2 week intensive better?
- Idea: Maybe stagger times of rehearsals to avoid conflicts?
- Idea: Maybe a survey, what grade is your child in? Would you prefer a 2 week intensive or a 2 month production?
- Does it have to be Tuesday/Thursday? Answer: Yes.

Action Items:

Play committee to move forward with Leslie, get her CORI, send out flyer to parents introducing Leslie and announcing the meet and greet, online survey to be written by the committee and sent out through the Downey school to gage availability and interest in the Tuesday/Thursday 3:15-5:15 proposed play schedule.

# 6. OPEN MEETING FOR DOWNEY COMMUNITY TO BEGIN AT 8PM Principal Gallagher Update

8:15pm-8:25pm

Discussion: Update

- Dismissal update- all the walkers changed to gym door for safety and security reasons.
- Safety concerns: kids are crossing the street while their parents are chatting.
- Community officers don't feel like the parking is unsafe, people don't want to park on Putting and Smith.
- District is pursuing a security audit, they will be looking at all parts of the building and offering feedback
- Question: will audit involve looking at windows in the school?
- Audit will involve interviews with principals, teacher forum, parent forum, checking nighttime access to the building, will make recommendations
- December is national inclusion month for schools: what are we doing? Don't want to put a spotlight on it; this is what we do here.
- We will be broadcasting a live webcast from the building on December 11, on the Rescue and Jessica book that promotes inclusion
- Filming live from Downey school. Small audience of about 18-20 kids. 3 kids from each k and 1<sup>st</sup> grade class. Other classrooms will log on and watch from their classrooms.
- Piloting a peer mentoring program, starting with 5<sup>th</sup> graders, peer mentors will give up recess once a week to reach out to certain kids in the building, a great leadership opportunity, hoping to roll out right after thanksgiving.
- Additional question brought up by board: Spirit shirts? Should we order more? Maybe order more smalls and extra smalls? Answer: Aren't we trying to deplete the stock?

Action Items:

Principal Gallagher, staff, and parents to participate in schoolwide safety audit. Principal to share findings with the community. Students to participate in Rescue and Jessica live webcast broadcast from Downey. Peer mentoring program to begin after Thanksgiving break.
