Message from the Principal

Hanlon Community,

While I enjoy the restorative aspects of the longer December break, I look forward to the new year. Since we've been back, I have witnessed significant growth across our students when compared to the fall. Whether it is growth in reading, mastery of math concepts, problem solving conflicts, or our Kindergartners being able to open their chocolate milk at lunch, the learning and development of independence is why I love this job.

While I think the break was great for everyone, one thing I have noticed since we have returned is an uptick in students bringing in things from home that are distracting to them. I'm asking you to partner with us to limit them bringing in toys or non-essential items that are distracting or become a problem with other students. Additionally, I've noticed a number of students who are wearing smart watches or exercise tracking devices. Over the past couple of weeks we have had students playing video games, taking pictures, making and receiving calls and "trying to get their steps in" by shaking their arms throughout class. I'd strongly encourage families to consider leaving these at home. If they are a distraction they will be told to put them in their backpack.

Finally, as a member of this learning community, I want to thank the PTO for funding an enrichment event during Inclusive Schools Week. Actors demonstrated how we can be inclusive of everyone and their ideas through the use of improvisation, it was a great event. Over the past two school years, I am continually impressed by our PTO's ability to provide high quality after school events for our children. These are only possible through caregiver volunteering and participation. This year has seen a decline in volunteer support and that has impacted their ability to run some traditional events. Please consider volunteering for some of the upcoming events (see below). I used to help at my kids school for evening PTO events. It's usually not a big lift, you get to hang out with other parents and put some faces to the names you hear. Additionally, if you haven't signed up for the PTO family communication system, <u>AtoZ connect</u>, please consider doing so. It's how you will hear about upcoming events and our spring is usually more packed.

Car Idling - As a district we are making a concerted effort to limit bus and car idling at our schools. As you wait for your children please ensure that your car is off, it keeps us healthier and keeps our air cleaner. Massachusetts law states that cars cannot idle on school grounds for more than 5 minutes.

Attendance Reporting- This year ALL attendance reporting must be done through <u>School Dismissal Manager (SDM)</u>. This means any absences, late arrivals, or dismissal changes for any student should be reflected in the SDM system. SDM streamlines dismissal to ensure the office, teachers and Extended Day staff are all on the same page that every student is dismissed safely to the proper place. It is important to check your students' dismissal schedule at the beginning of every week to make sure it is accurate. Please note that your communication with the school is not limited to SDM, and if you feel that an additional note or dialogue is needed to clarify a situation, we encourage you to contact the office.

Lunch Ordering - The Commonwealth of Massachusetts has decided to extend free school meals for all students through the 2022-2023 school year! This means that every student is eligible to receive one free lunch each day. Classroom

teachers will do lunch counts each morning for students who will be getting lunch from the cafeteria. While lunch is free, *MySchoolBucks* is where funds are deposited for the purchase of a la carte and extra items (i.e., **milk** alone). School lunch menus are viewable <u>here</u>. Families are encouraged to reach out to Food Services with any dietary restrictions.



Aspen Portal - If you haven't already done so, please be certain to go into the Aspen portal to review and update all information. This includes renewing permissions each year. I encourage all of you to select "Yes" for

media permissions. This allows your child to be in school photographs on our website and participate in photos during special events. In addition to media permission, permission to release directory info to the PTO/PTA is included in the contact verification and permissions. If you have any questions about the media or directory permissions, please contact me at mkuklentz@westwood.k12.ma.us. Changes may be made by <u>updating your Aspen account online</u>. As of right now, a large handful of parents/students need to read and confirm they have read the student handbook. As a reminder, parents are not included in the PTO directory until they confirm they have read the handbook.

PTO Communications - Please consider registering your family on our communications platform, *AtoZConnect*. By doing so, you ensure that your family receives PTO newsletters, information about upcoming events and programs, and communications from your student's room parents. Additionally, you may pay dues, purchase event tickets and other items, and sign up to volunteer through this account. *Your contact information (email/phone) can remain private if you choose and no physical address information is published.* <u>Click here</u> to review or enter your student and contact information in the system.
