




#### **WELCOME TO THE NEW ONLINE DIRECTORY!**



We are excited to share with you that starting this year Martha Jones PTO is using AtoZConnect as our school directory. AtoZConnect is a secure web-based system that allows parents to verify and edit their own directory listings. This will replace the printed directory we have provided in the past. With AtoZConnect you will be able to update your own information if it changes. You will also be able to access the directory on the go and always have it at your fingertips.

The Martha Jones PTO Board decided to move to AtoZConnect as it is environmentally friendly and will eliminate the flyers that have traditionally gone home in backpacks. AtoZConnect will also streamline all the communication you receive from the PTO into one place eliminating the need to search your email inbox for information. It is our hope that AtoZConnect will help families feel more connected to the Martha Jones community especially during this unprecedented year.

By now you should have received two emails asking you to verify your information. One dated September 29 from the "Martha Jones PTO" and one dated October 6 from the "Martha Jones PTO Board." In both these emails you were asked to verify your information if you haven't already. #### **JOIN THE MARTHA JONES PTO**

Once you have verified your information in AtoZ, you will also be invited to join the Martha Jones PTO. The cost of a PTO membership is \$45 for families with one child and \$55 for families with two or more children. A PTO membership gives you access to the full Martha Jones directory on AtoZConnect. If you

do not sign up for PTO membership, you will not have access to the directory. However, you still will have an AtoZConnect account and the ability to update your information and receive all PTO notices.

Support of the PTO through a PTO membership helps fund events, special projects, and educational programs throughout the year. The PTO Board is already working on ways to convert many of our traditional in-person highlights to social distanced events this year. Now more than ever we want to make sure we provide fun, engaging activities to help your children feel connected.


