Message from the Principal

We have finally reached the last month of 2020. With the COVID vaccine on the horizon, let's hope that 2021 is a much brighter year for all of us and we can get back to our more typical lives sooner rather than later.

Flu Shots - Just a reminder that all students are now required to have a flu vaccine by December 31, 2020 in order to attend public school. I know many of you have already sent in copies of your child's flu vaccine. If you haven't done so, please do so as soon as possible. Students will not be able to return from winter break without documentation of a flu vaccine.

Clearance by COVID Team for return to school when traveling outside of Massachusetts. I recognize that in the past, many of our families have headed north for skiing and snowboarding activities during the winter and some of you have homes in other states. Please remember that any student who travels outside of Massachusetts will need to follow travel guidelines before returning to school. This includes providing the WPS Covid Team with the results of a negative COVID test or guarantining as directed by the COVID team. If your child travels outside of Massachusetts for any reason, you must contact the COVID team at wpscovidteam@westwood.k12.ma.us to inform them of your travel plans and to be cleared to return to school. All negative test results should be emailed to the COVID team at least 24 hours before your child returns to school so that someone from the team can review the results and contact the appropriate school that the student may return. Students not cleared for return will be sent home. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

Dress in Layers - Just a reminder that we keep the windows open to help rotate fresh air through the classrooms. All classrooms have windows and our ventilation systems rotate air. We also have air purifiers in any spaces that do not have windows (a few offices, small group spaces, etc.). Because classroom windows will be kept open, even when the heat is on, the rooms can become chilly. Please be sure your child has a sweater or sweatshirt with them that they can wear during the school day, if needed. In addition, students should have appropriate outside wear each day including, coats, hats, mittens and snow pants when weather requires them. Label, Label, Label

Towels for Outside - We continue to work to have some special classes, lunch, mask breaks, and playtime each day. For the most part, the weather has cooperated. Students have been great about bringing in their beach towels each day, please keep it up. It is very helpful for them to have something to sit on when outside.

Conferences - Parent/Teacher conferences will wrap up this week. The afternoon of Wednesday, December 9th is reserved for parent/teacher conferences. If you have not scheduled a conference yet and would like one, please reach out to your child's teacher.

Masks - Students have been truly wonderful about keeping their masks on. Please remember that students need to arrive at school each day with a mask. Masks need to be at least two ply and cover from the bridge of the nose to under the chin.

Staff Gifts

As we approach the holiday season many parents ask about gifts. Teacher gifts are optional and no one should feel obligated to participate. However, if you are considering a teacher gift, or contributing to a class gift, please note that public employees, including teachers, are not permitted to accept personal gifts with a value of \$50 or higher. Class gifts up to \$150 may be given if the gift is identified as only being from the class and the identity of individual givers and/or amounts are not identified to the recipient.
