This year in Mr. Parkhurst's class students have been participating in the Stock Market Game. Students are given an imaginary \$100,000 to invest in the stock market. Our technology specialist, Mr. Goguen, led the students in lessons about how to research companies to invest in, when to buy and sell, diversification, and on bonds and mutual funds.

Students were fully engaged and had great fun and success. In the Fall session of the game, 2 teams from the class finished in the top 10 in Massachusetts. The partnership of Avery Tessier and Layla Klaene (a.k.a. Money Queens) were 6th place in the state with a total of \$118,579.04. The team of Kate Tateosian and Renzi Schelenski (a.k.a. Bob Ross Bills) were 8th place in the state with a total of \$118,079.50.

News from 1B (Ms. Brock)



News from the Music Room (Mrs. Pickering)









An important part of our First Grade Music curriculum focuses on celebrating with music. By the end of our year, students will understand that:


- I can make music with my friends and family.

In the Learning Center, the second grade students are working on a new math concept. They have been actively working on solving addition and subtraction word problems with both single and double-digit numbers with success. Most recently, they have been introduced to the concept of an identifying an "unknown change." This concept involves analyzing the wording given a mathematical word problem and identifying the parts that you "know" and part that represent an "unknown change." Students read the problem and underline the important information/ key words and through discussion, they determine which parts of the problem are "known" or "unknown." Unknown parts are marked with a question mark. From there, the second graders work on determining if the problem that they are solving requires addition or subtraction and generate an accompanying equation using an empty box to represent the "unknown change." They then choose

a previously introduced computation strategy to solve the problem. The second graders are off to a good start!

International Night


Celebrating & showcasing cultures from various countries around the world!
