News from KF (Mrs. Fader)








In Kindergarten, students have been working on managing difficult emotions through positive self talk. The Martha Jones students have been very busy learning about Fitness! This unit introduced fitness concepts such as: Stretching, target heart rate, proper form and safety, through circuit training, fitness challenges, and fitness games. A variety of highly active games were introduced to teach and reemphasize fitness concepts. The kids had a blast! News from the Math Office - Ms. Size



In grade 1 we have been using different contexts for thinking about the number 10. We have especially been focusing on "10s buddies", which are 2 numbers that sum to 10. We read a book called <u>Monster Math Picnic</u> where the 10 monsters do two different things on each page spread, thereby decomposing into 10s addends by page. We then explored how we can represent 10s buddies on our ten fingers using cubes to show the parts.
