Over the past month the Martha Jones has been fortunate to have a number of all school enrichment opportunities. As you know we had Valerie Tutson earlier in February and this week we had a local author, Jef Czekaj, visit us. In addition to highlighting the writing and illustrating process, he encouraged our students to work hard on the things that they love. Mr. Czekaj held other jobs prior to being discovered at Comic Book Convention by Nickelodeon which propelled his career. His multimedia presentation to the students was fun and engaging.

We have also had a number of visits by the Discovery Museum, Top Secret Science, and the WPS Science Coordinator, Kate Doyle, and Science Specialist, Jennie Goossen. These visits allow students to have hands on science experiences that connect to the Massachusetts Curriculum Frameworks. For example, our 1st graders learned about lights and lasers this week. Ms. Doyle and Mrs. Goosen used a fog machine to show how light waves worked. While I held my breath that the fog machines didn't inadvertently set off our smoke detectors, the students were engrossed in learning how light waves moved. The students had a fun time learning and we didn't have an unanticipated fire drill (Wednesday's fire drill was planned).



What is a digraph?

In Kindergraten, we have begun exploring digraphs during our literacy block. A digraph is made up of two letters that work together to make one unique sound. For example, "sh" in the word shop creates one single phoneme (sound). The "s" and "h" have two distinct sounds, but used together they represent the sound /sh/.














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








In math, third graders have been studying the different attributes of quadrilaterals and triangles. They have been building various polygons and noticing the similarities and differences between them.



News from Music (Mrs. Saada-Smith)






News from Mrs. Tucceri - Speech Language Corner







Many of the students in speech have been working on improving their word-finding abilities. Word-finding difficulties in children can pose significant challenges in communication and academic performance. These struggles often manifest as difficulty retrieving specific words or recalling vocabulary during conversations or when expressing thoughts. To assist children with word-finding difficulties, engaging in language-rich activities like word games can be beneficial. Games such as Charades, Scattegories, Word Whiz, and Word Joggers can help stimulate word retrieval skills in a

fun and interactive manner. Additionally, incorporating activities that encourage categorization and semantic organization, such as sorting games or creating word webs, can enhance word recall abilities. Moreover, providing a supportive and patient environment where children feel encouraged to express themselves without fear of judgment can facilitate their language development and confidence in verbal communication. Through these strategies, children can improve their word-finding abilities while enjoying the process of learning and playing.


MJS Parent Social - Tomorrow Night!!
