The Westwood firefighters came to visit our class last week. They taught us about how to get help in an emergency and showed us what their equipment is like.






News from the Music (Mrs. Pickering)



News from the Mrs. Tucceri



Speech and Language News with Mrs. Tucceri:

During speech-language sessions, many students have been working on developing their storytelling skills. Developing oral narratives in school-age children is essential for enhancing their communication and cognitive skills. One effective method is through the use of wordless books, which encourage children to construct their own stories based on the visual cues provided. Two examples are *frog where are you?* by Mercer Mayer and *Good Dog, Carl* by Alexandra Day. These books stimulate creativity, comprehension, and language development as children explore the



illustrations and articulate their interpretations. Additionally, engaging in open-ended discussions, encouraging imaginative play, and promoting storytelling activities can further nurture a child's ability to organize thoughts, express ideas coherently, and build a strong foundation for both written and oral communication skills. By fostering the art of oral narration, educators and parents can empower children to become effective communicators and confident storytellers.


