June 7 Field Day



Hanlon Arts Night


Congratulations to Ms. Goodwin and Ms. Pickering for putting on a successful Art Show. We had a great turnout from students and families who came to see artwork and

On Thursday, March 30th, more than 40 parents from across the district attended the Tech Us Out night at Martha Jones. The evening was designed as an opportunity to experience the technology that 3rd through 5th grade students use regularly. Participants used student Chromebooks and joined a Google Classroom. They created a short friendly letter and then shared it with their child. Another activity required everyone to simultaneously work on a shared document. The Google Read & Write extension and voice-to-text input were also reviewed. The event concluded with a self-paced scavenger hunt while exploring Google Drive. In the end, the event was all about helping parents gain familiarity with the technology their children use in school so they can better assist the learning process at home.
