## **WPS Calendar and School Day Hours:**

- A one-page printout of the updated <u>2022-2023 school calendar</u>, including school hours, is available on the district website.
- School Day Hours: 8:50am 3:10pm
- Morning Arrival: 8:30am 8:50am
- **Dismissal:** 3:10pm (11:50am on early-release Wednesdays)

## **Schedule for the Opening of School:**

- Wednesday, August 31st:
  - First day of school for all students in grades 1-5
  - Open House for Kindergarten students and families from 9:00am 11:00am (Additional information regarding the start of Kindergarten is also included in a separate attached letter.)
- Thursday, September 1st:
  - Second day of school for all students in grades 1-5
  - First day of school for all students in Kindergarten (This is an early-release day for our Kindergarten students. They will be dismissed at 11:50am.)
- Friday, September 2nd and Monday, September 5th:
  - o All Westwood Public Schools will be closed for the Labor Day weekend
- Tuesday, September 6th:
  - Full day of school for all students in grades K-5

#### **Morning Arrival:**

- Our morning arrival will take place between 8:30am 8:45am each day. Students who arrive between 8:30am 8:45am will begin their day on the playground where staff members supervise a morning arrival time. In the case of inclement weather, students will proceed directly to their classrooms upon arrival. At 8:45am, a bell will ring calling students to line-up and proceed to their classrooms. *Please do not drop your child off before 8:30am. We are not able to provide supervision of students prior to that time.*
- Students who arrive after 8:50am are tardy and must check-in at the main office before
  proceeding to their classrooms. Please make every effort to help your child arrive before
  our 8:50am start time.

## **Afternoon Dismissal:**

- Our afternoon dismissal takes place at 3:10pm for all regular school days and at 11:50am on early-release days.
- Students dismissed as car pick-ups:
  - Beginning at 3:10pm, family members picking their child(ren) up as a car pick-up will arrive in the front circle. Please do not arrive in the front circle prior to 3:05pm (11:45am on early-release days) to avoid cars backing up onto Deerfield Avenue and blocking traffic.
  - Please place a <u>Deerfield Student Arrival and Dismissal Placard</u> in the dashboard or passenger side window of your car with the following information:
    - Student's name
    - Grade

- Homeroom teacher
- Staff members will check family members' IDs, as needed.

## • Students riding home on the bus:

- As buses arrive, students will be called for dismissal (via the intercom) to proceed to the gym.
- Staff members will check students off the bus list when they board the bus and will signal to the bus driver when all students are on and the bus can leave.

## • Students dismissed as walkers:

- Beginning at 3:10pm, parents/family members picking their child(ren) up as walkers will arrive at the gate of the outdoor classroom on the Deerfield Avenue side.
- Parents will hold a <u>Deerfield Student Arrival and Dismissal Placard</u> with the following information:
  - Student's name
  - Grade
  - Homeroom teacher
- At 3:10pm, students who are walking home, will be called for dismissal (via the intercom) to proceed to the outdoor classroom.
- Students will be met at the outdoor classroom door by the staff members on duty.
- Students with permission to walk home on their own will exit the building through the outdoor classroom and walk home.
- Students who are walking home with a family member will proceed to the outdoor classroom and wait for their family member to arrive.
- Staff members will supervise students in the outdoor classroom and dismiss them when their family member arrives.
- o Staff members will check family members' IDs, as needed.

#### **Lunch and Recess:**

- Students have thirty minutes for lunch and thirty minutes for recess during the school day. There are no lunch or recess periods on early release days.
- School Lunch will be free to all students for the 2022-2023 School Year. However, school lunches need to be ordered online prior to the start of the school day. ## **School Safety:**

The safety and well-being of our students is the highest priority for every Deerfield staff member. To that end, we have many safety measures in place at Deerfield and across the entire Westwood Public Schools district. Below is a partial list of these safety measures:

- Deerfield students and staff practice building evacuations and lockdown drills several times each year. These drills are supervised and facilitated by the Westwood police and fire departments.
- All exterior doors are locked during the school day. The front entryway can be viewed on security cameras that are monitored from two locations in the main office. *All visitors must enter the school through the front entryway*.
- All visitors will be asked their name and the purpose of their visit upon arrival. Upon entering the building, all visitors must report to the main office to sign in. Please note:
   Students and faculty members are not permitted to open the door for visitors.
