What is SEPAC?



The Westwood Special Education Parent Advisory Council (SEPAC) is a state-mandated, parent-run group working to promote a **network of parents, guardians, and caregivers of children with special needs**.

SEPAC **partners** with the Director of Student Services and the School Committee on policies. We **receive input** from parents, teachers and others to **encourage understanding**, **acceptance**, **and inclusion** of all special education students.

What we do... Advocacy, Education and Support



- ★ Advise the School Committee on matters that pertain to the education and safety of students with disabilities
- ★ Meet regularly with school officials to participate in the planning, development and evaluation of the district's special education programs
 - We liaise and are supported by our Abby Hansom, Director of Student Services and other district leaders
- ★ Provide a forum to share information and discuss matters of common concern and interest among parents and caregivers
 - We do this through regular meetings, workshops, district presentations and networking meet & greets that connect parents & caregivers of special needs children



How we do it... SEPAC: Advocacy, Education and Support

- ★ Executive Board
- ★ SEPAC Representatives/Liaisons at Each of our 7 Schools and a Community Liaison
 - Spread the word about SEPAC Events with the PTO and parents, the school principal, & special education teachers
 - Fosters inclusion in the school community
 - Provide insight on special education issues to the PTO Board and Event Chairs on accommodations to consider for events
 - For example some schools have implemented sensory friendly PTO events
 - The representatives work directly with special education teachers and PTO Boards regarding needs for equipment and supplies.
- ★ Subcommittees
 - SEPAC form subcommittees as needed to take on special projects or whenever a need is identified
