PUBLIC HEALTH INFORMATION REGARDING CORONAVIRUS

February 26, 2020

Dear Westwood Parents:

I am writing to provide information about the respiratory disease COVID-19 or the "coronavirus."

As of this writing, Massachusetts has one confirmed case of COVID-19 and the risk to our residents remains low. At the same time, the risk for the influenza virus is high.

The Westwood Public Schools is in communication with the Westwood Department of Public Health, the Massachusetts Executive Offices of Health and Human Services Department of Public Health, the MA Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, and our school physician. These agencies and clinicians are providing guidance to school administrators and school health personnel regarding COVID-19. We communicate daily with public health officials to ensure that we have the most upto-date information and are implementing appropriate guidance. The most recent update includes:

- Risk to Massachusetts residents who have not visited China remains low.
- Precautions to prevent colds and flu will also prevent transmission of COVID-19.
- Individuals are to continue with hand hygiene, cough etiquette, and staying home when sick.
- Schools have been instructed to continue with regular cleaning and disinfecting processes.

All local health departments in the region, including Westwood, continue to monitor the situation and take part in weekly conference calls.
