New Menu Options and Information on Ordering Lunch If You Haven't Already Done So - Our food service department is working hard to provide additional lunch options for elementary students (yesterday's Snow Flake Waffles were a huge hit). This year, all lunches are individually prepared so please be sure to order lunch ahead of time for your child. Directions for ordering lunch can be found ere. Remember to select the blue "checkout" box once you have made lunch selections. Please be sure to check out the menus and order lunch ahead of time. On days that popular items are served, we often have students come to the office because they've decided they want to buy lunch, but extra lunches are not often available this year. There are lunch options for students who forgot to order, so no one goes hungry, but it is often not the option the students wanted to select.

MCAS Schedule for students in Grades 3, 4, & 5. The Department of Elementary and Secondary Education recently pushed out the MCAS testing window which will now be open starting May 10th. Martha Jones students in Grades 3, 4, and 5 will participate in ELA MCAS testing on May 11th and Math MCAS testing on May 18th and Grade 5 students will participate in the Science and Technology/Engineering MCAS test on May 20th. Prior to the MCAS testing window, I will hold a virtual Principal's coffee for parents who are interested in finding out more about MCAS.
