Message from the Principal

Virtual Conferences and Status Reports



Conferences will be held on the afternoons of November 18th and December 9th. There will also be a limited number of evening conference times available as well. If you have not scheduled a conference time with your child's teacher yet, he or she will be

reaching out soon to set up a time. All conferences will be held virtually this year. During the virtual conferences, teachers will share with you how your child is adjusting to school this year and any successes and/or challenges he/she is having participating in his/her school work and/or engaging with his/her classmates and teachers.

While in the past we provided written status reports at conference time, it did not seem reasonable to rate students on areas such as following classroom routines, effort, and work habits. Given this new school environment and a hybrid model that is vastly different from what students have experienced in the past, the fact that they are coming to school each day and engaging in their school community is a testament to their resilience and flexibility.

We expect that written report cards for all students and progress notes for students on IEPs will be sent home at the end of Jan and in June, as they have in the past.
