Message from the Principal

Important COVID Updates in a Snapshot:

Lunch:

- Starting on Monday, February 14, 2022 all students will be eating next to each other at the round tables in the cafeteria.
- Students will no longer need to pre-order lunch. Effective immediately LINQ is no longer being used. Instead, students will select the lunch they want, in person, in the cafeteria serving line. Lunch will still be free, but children will need to have many on their <u>MYSCHOOLBUCKS</u> accounts if they are bringing their lunch but want to purchase milk only. Lemma Jn-baptiste will be sending out a district wide communication with more complete details.

Masking:

- As per the school committee vote at last night's meeting, *effective Monday, February 28, 2022,* we will transition to a "mask optional" environment for students and staff. We ask for your support in ensuring that all members of the school community support each individual's choice about whether or not to wear a mask. Please remind your child to be respectful of their classmate's decisions about whether or not to mask.
- Federal mandates require that masks still be worn on school buses at this time.
- Supt. Parks will be sending out a district communication regarding the update to the masking policy. Please see her communication for more details.

Classroom Happenings

News from PE (Mr. Foley) - What's Happening in Physical Education! The Martha Jones students have been very busy learning about Fitness! This unit introduced fitness concepts such as: stretching, target heart rate, proper form and safety, through circuit training, fitness challenges, and games. These activities emphasized the importance of keeping physically fit. The students also learned about the importance of keeping their heart and other body muscles strong! A variety of highly active

games were introduced to teach and re-emphasize fitness concepts. The kids had a blast! Learning to enjoy physical fitness activities is one the most important motivational factors for staying physically fit! In the upstairs Learning Center, we have been learning about being kind to ourselves. To kickstart February, we read and listen to books about Valentine's Day and being kind. The students discussed ways they are special and unique. Each student adult and in the Learning Center shared two why reasons they love themselves. Our bulletin board promotes kindness and love for others as well as ourselves. Happy Valentine's Day! Love yourself- Just as you are :)



News from 4W (Mrs. Waldner)

Hello from 4th grade! In our fourth grade science unit about energy, we are learning about energy! Students in 4W thought about where our bodies, cars, and windup toys get their energy from. We investigated energy sources and then created a rollercoaster ride to explore how we could supply energy to the ride in order for the riders to have fun! This rollercoaster ride was called a twist-o-matic! Students explored how fast the ride could go using different size rubber bands and found that wider rubber bands stored more energy. Students then explored how they would power their ride. The class brainstormed energy options including peanut oil, wind turbines, and machines powered by electricity.

The students in 4W enjoyed designing and creating a rollercoaster ride to explore energy. Next week, we will be exploring how energy is transferred in another theme park ride!







News from 2H (Ms. Hartwell) - Children are natural born Scientists. They are curious about the world around them. They ask wonderful questions, actively explore, and make insightful connections. In 2H, we



studied "Slow Changes to Earth". During this unit, we explored weathering and erosion. We learned about wind and water erosion. These elements change the surface of our planet over time. How did we do this you may ask? We used sugar cubes! In our first experiment, we examined the sugar cubes and wrote down our observations. We placed the sugar cubes in a container and shook, shook, shook. The children discussed and examined the sugar cube after each turn. They noticed changes caused by the shaking and friction. In the end, the sugar cube was no longer a cube but a sphere, and particles we called "sand sugar" were left at the bottom of the container. In our next

experiment, we made a mountain out of snow, and slowly poured warm colored water over the top. The colored water ended up changing the surface of our mountain; and a river formed. Water pooled at the bottom of the snow mountain forming a lake. The young scientists in 2H embraced these big concepts and connected them to the world in which we live.
